With this skill set, you will be equipped to offer person-centered support to individuals with disabilities in a variety of community service and health settings. You will learn to implement behavior support strategies and contribute to individual plans, helping to foster the ongoing skills development of individuals with disabilities.

Additionally, you will gain the skills necessary to empower individuals with disabilities and provide rights-based, person-centered services. The focus of this skill set is to assist individuals with disabilities in participating fully in community settings and promoting their psychosocial well-being. Upon completion of this industry-standard skill set, you will be well-prepared to offer individualized support in a range of disability service contexts.

This skill set is to support those that **already hold a Certificate III Qualification** in this sector to expand their skills and knowledge to provide care and support to older people and people with disability.

For example, students who have already completed a Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing, Home and Community) and want to upskill to enrol in the Certificate IV in Disability Support could undertake the skill set.*

*The CHC4321 Certificate IV in Disability Support requires that students have completed either the CHC33021 Certificate III in Individual Support (Disability), the CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support (Disability), or the CHC30408 Certificate III in Disability plus the CHCSS00125 Entry to Certificate IV in Disability Support Skill Set.
