The 22471VIC Course in Initial General Education for Adults helps learners with low literacy and numeracy skills build confidence, re-engage with learning and the community, and find a pathway into study and employment.

Who is this training for?

The course will help learners build basic skills in:

- reading and writing
- using computers
- dealing with numbers and money
- measurement and shapes
- understanding tables and graphs
- speaking and listening
- general education.

- Classroom based

Duration

- Approximately 30 weeks (including holidays)
