The 22471VIC Course in Initial General Education for Adults helps learners with low literacy and numeracy skills build confidence, re-engage with learning and the community, and find a pathway into study and employment.

- · reading and writing
- using computers
- dealing with numbers and money
- measurement and shapes
- · understanding tables and graphs
- speaking and listening
- · general education.
