### **Course overview**

Disability workers provide personal, physical and emotional support to disabled people who require assistance with daily living. Care is provided either in their client's own home or in a residential care setting.

This qualification will equip you with the management qualities to supervise other employees, create frameworks for an effective workplace and assist you to empower your clients to participate in the community and seek an appropriate level of independence.

There is a strong growth projected for jobs in the disability and aged care. The industry needs diverse, qualified, compassionate carers like you!
