### Course overview

**Advance your career in the early childhood sector by up-skilling with a diploma.**

This level of an educator is responsible for planning, implementing and managing programs. You will be able to work at a senior level in a variety of roles, including designing and developing the curriculum and supervision of staff.

Throughout the course you will learn how to use a national learning framework, regulations and quality standards to support the education and care of children from birth to school age; planning for children with additional needs; networking; effective communication; family partnerships; and health and safety.

This course is based on the National Quality Framework and Early Years Framework and has an emphasis on play-based learning.

### Outcomes

This qualification can lead you to job roles such as:

- Children's services coordinator
- Centre manager
- Program leader
- Child development worker
- Early childhood Educator
- Children's adviser

### Delivery mode

- In-class (face-to-face)
- Remote Learning
- Workplace Traineeships

### Duration

Approximately **68 weeks**

You will be expected to attend **class 1 day per week.**

Recommended self-study time is a minimum of 10 hours per week.

The level of care will include assisting children with their daily routine, including eating, toileting, sleeping and dressing

Required to lift children and equipment

Required to stay on your feet for long periods
